

## State of California Proposition 65 Declaration

Dear Valued Customers,

California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, also known as Proposition 65, establishes a list of chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Monolithic Power Systems, Inc (MPS) is a fabless semiconductor company that outsources its manufacturing of silicon IC chips. The IC chips are approximately 2x2mm or 3x3mm in physical dimensions, always used inside electronic devices without direct exposure to consumers, and too small to be labeled with the required warnings. As such, Proposition 65 does not apply to MPS. However, MPS is fully compliant to the EU directive RoHS as well as the REACH initiative, and as a result, MPS does not expect any substances listed in Proposition 65 to be present in its Products.
